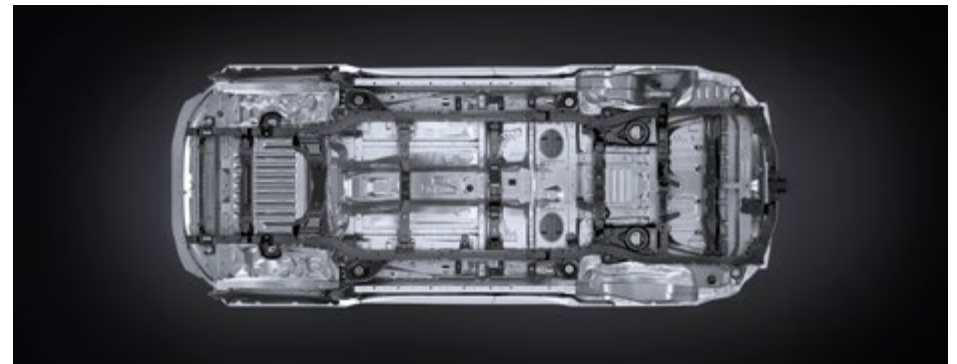

Platform

The GX represents the pinnacle of Lexus' true off-roaders, showcasing an evolved level of vehicle performance necessary to deliver exciting experiences to its customers. While preserving the traditional body-on-frame structure, the vehicle's framework has undergone a comprehensive overhaul. With the implementation of the GA-F platform and enhanced body rigidity, driving performance on all types of roads is remarkable. The adoption of the GA-F platform elevates collision safety performance, enhances

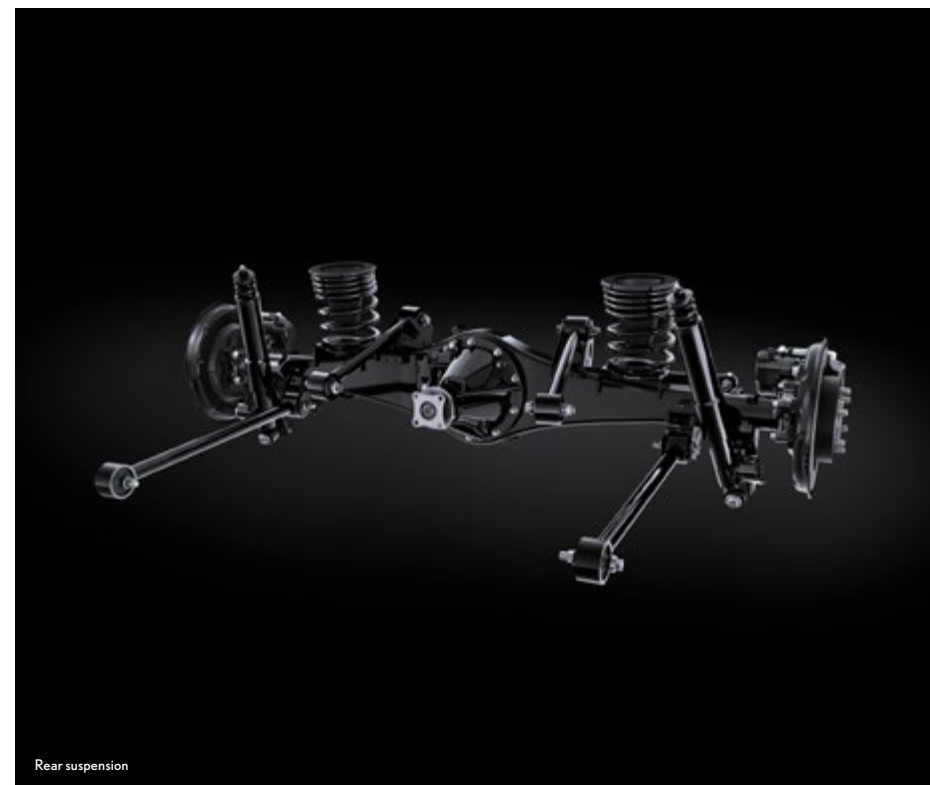
quietness, and refines overall driving quality. To provide the required strength and high rigidity without compromising weight, the GX strategically utilises a Tailor Welded Blank (TWB) technique, where steel materials of varying thicknesses and compositions are skillfully joined in specific locations for side rails and cross members. This meticulous approach provides optimal driving quality across diverse environments.

Suspension

The suspension system provides both off-road drivability and on-road handling stability at an exceptional level. The front suspension uses a high-mount double wishbone configuration, designed to deliver stable vehicle posture through the optimal suspension geometry. The coil spring rate has been fine-tuned, the caster trail has been increased, and the king pin offset has been minimised in order to maximise vehicle stability during straight-line driving, cornering, and braking, while also delivering a comfortable driving experience. At the rear, a 4-link rigid suspension with lateral control arms is employed to optimise the suspension arm, shock absorber arrangement and characteristics. This effectively controls the movement of the axle, enhancing vehicle stability during braking. The shock absorbers are equipped with



independent telescopic valves (Luxury models only) and Friction Control Device (FCD), while the rigidity of the fastening components has been enhanced through increased torque applied to the suspension peripheral parts. The suspension characteristics have been optimised to provide both vehicle stability and ride comfort, enabled by enhancements in rigidity. Building upon the GX's established reputation, the rigid suspension system has been thoroughly refined to further enhance off-road drivability. The shock absorber layout has been optimised to minimise the impact of external disturbances and enhance the overall dampening efficiency of the suspension system, making it easier to control vehicle movement. Additionally, the extension of wheel articulation further enhances traction on rocky and mogul roads.

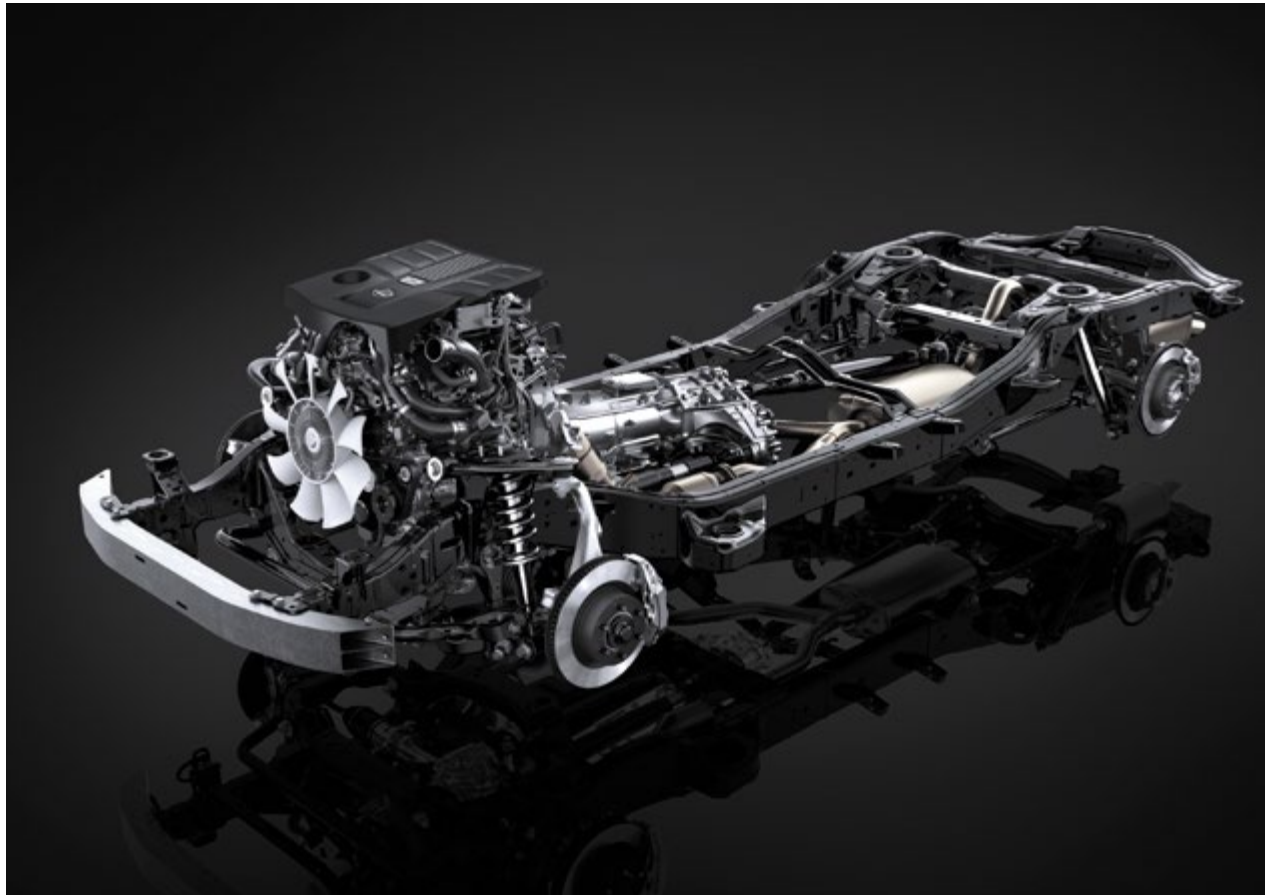

Multi Material Body

The lightweight, high-rigidity body was created with the application of advanced materials and technologies. The use of linear/non-linear TWB for the frame side rails and cross members enables a strong and rigid frame while significantly reducing weight. Aluminium alloy and high tensile strength steel in the upper cabin contribute to its lightweight and high strength, while the use of aluminium alloy for the hood panel further reduces weight.

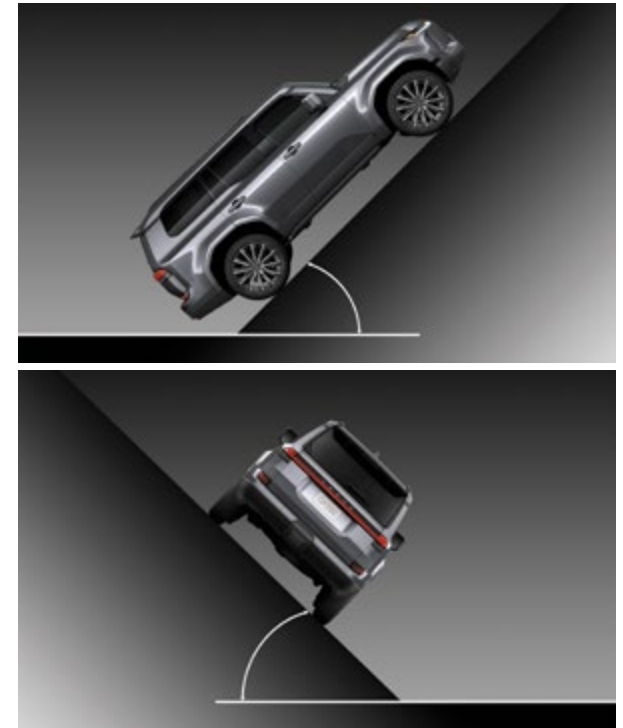
The V35A-FTS engine is mated to a direct-shift 10-speed automatic transmission (AT). Delivering a direct and engaging feeling, the 10-speed AT features a lock-up clutch that operates in most situations, except during start-ups, thereby enhancing the overall driving experience. It also enabled cross-gear implementation and a wide

range of overall gear ratios. This brings about a rhythmic and pleasant driving experience, as well as simultaneous enhancements in fuel efficiency, start-up acceleration, and off-road performance.

Moreover, the drive force characteristics and gear shift timing have been optimised resulting in dynamic acceleration that aligns with the driver's intentions, harnessing a delightful sense of acceleration that fully utilises the extended torque characteristics throughout the high rpm range.

The sharp approach angle and short front overhang provide a design worthy of a genuine Lexus off-roader and a package that delivers excellent off-road durability.

Wheel Articulation

Available on Overtrail grade only, the Electronic-Kinetic Dynamic Suspension System (E-KDSS) provides a high level balance between offroad drivability, ride comfort and on-road handling stability. Driving slowly on unpaved roads the suspension stabilisers are free to move to minimise rocking of the vehicle body, reducing head rock, while on the open road the stabilisers are locked to reduce dizzy feelings. The rigid rear suspension with extended wheel articulation also enhances traction on rocky and mogul roads.

Multi-terrain Select¹ (Available on Overtrail models only)

Multi-terrain Select offers six modes (AUTO, DIRT, SAND, MUD, DEEP SNOW, and ROCK) for off-road driving support. Incorporating integrated control of drive torque and suspension, the system goes beyond conventional hydraulic brakes to empower the driver with enhanced driving performance tailored to various road conditions. Furthermore, the operating range includes both low range (L4) and high range (H4), to offer outstanding versatility. Multi-terrain Select has evolved to enable superior driving performance on

all types of roads worldwide, ranging from navigating rocky terrains at extremely low speeds to cruising at higher speeds on unpaved roads. Furthermore, in AUTO mode, the system utilises data from multiple sensors to estimate the road surface conditions in real-time. It then optimises the brake hydraulics, drive torque, and suspension control accordingly. This eliminates the need for the driver to manually switch modes and allows for maximum driving performance according to the driving situation.

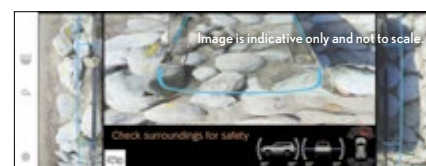

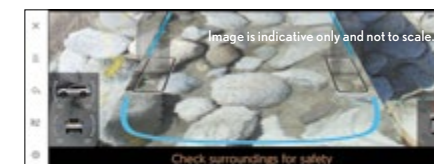

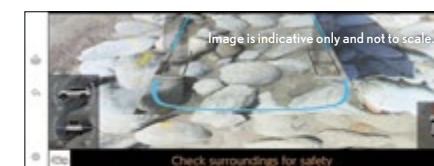

Multi-terrain Monitor¹ (Available on Overtrails models only)

The Multi-terrain Monitor is an advanced system designed for off-road driving, utilising four cameras to assist the driver in monitoring the surroundings of the vehicle. With cameras mounted on the front, sides, and rear, the system seamlessly switches between camera feeds, displaying high-definition images on the 14-inch screen. This provides the driver with a clear and smooth view of the vehicle's surroundings, especially in areas that may be difficult to see. By activating the under-floor view, previous footage is

displayed as a transparent image, along with indicators showing the current position of the vehicle and tyres. This allows the driver to assess the condition under the vehicle and the positioning of the front wheels. Additionally, an advanced function allows the vehicle to become transparent and provides a close-up view of the area around the rear wheels. This feature assists the driver in understanding the proximity of obstacles and aids in manoeuvring out of challenging situations such as being stuck or encountering a dead end.

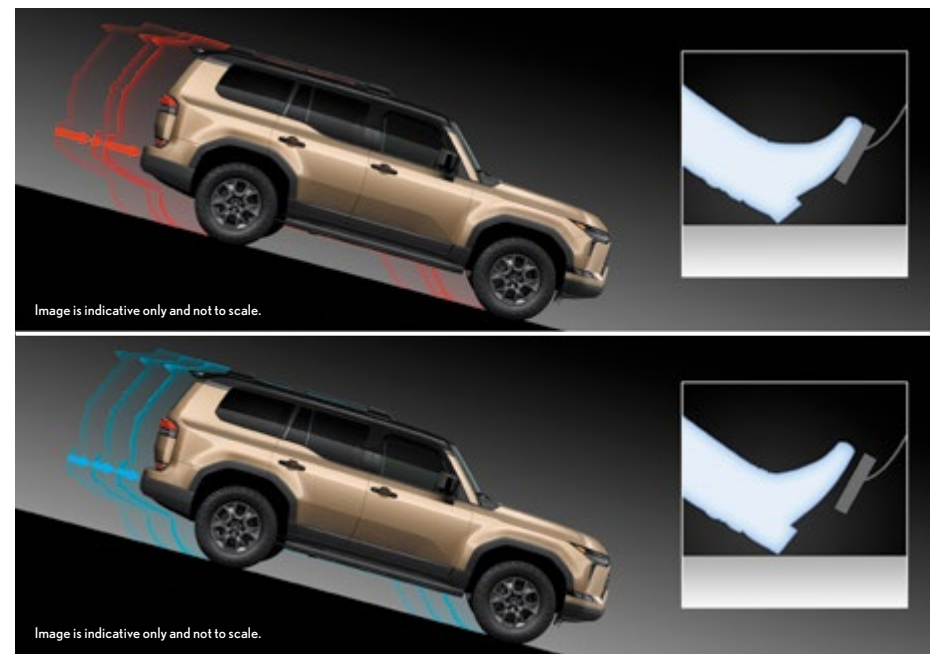

Crawl Control²

Crawl Control, available on Overtrail grade only, is designed to alleviate the driving burden when driving over uneven or slippery off-road terrain. Drive torque and hydraulic brake pressure are automatically controlled according to five speed settings. Extreme low-speed driving only requires steering wheel operation, without the need for acceleration or braking. The vehicle has a strong capability to escape from being stuck, as it effectively reduces wheel spin and wheel lock, thus minimising strain on the drivetrain.



Downhill Assist Control²

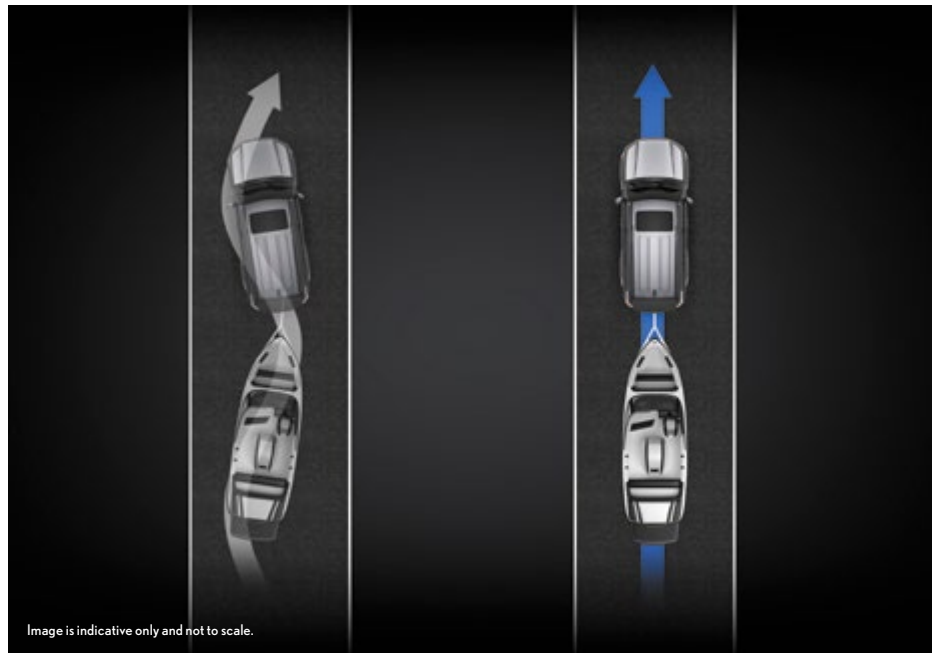
Downhill Assist Control, available on Overtrail grade only, is designed to reduce the driving burden on steep slopes, and automatically adjusts the hydraulic pressure of the brakes on each wheel independently, when descending steep slopes where engine braking alone may not provide sufficient deceleration, for a stable descent without tyre lock-up. By maintaining the selected vehicle speed through switch operation, the driver can focus on steering without worrying about brake or accelerator operation, effectively reducing the driving workload.¹

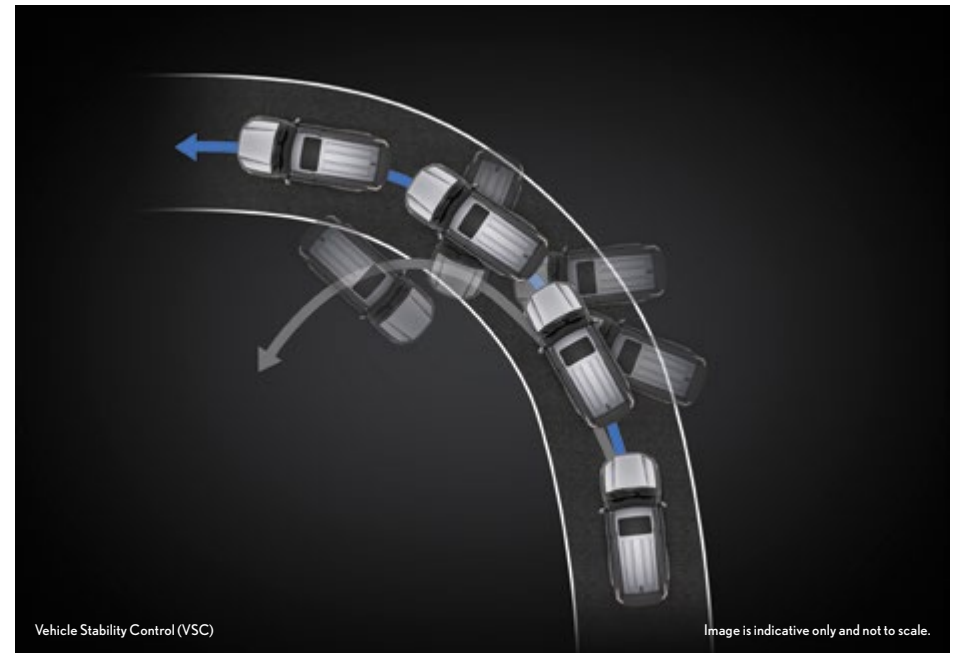

Trailer Sway Control^{1,2}

The vehicle features Trailer Sway Control, which effectively manages any sway detected from the towed trailer. This system applies individual brake pressure to all four wheels based on the situation, thereby stabilising the vehicle's posture and helping facilitate safe and confident towing.



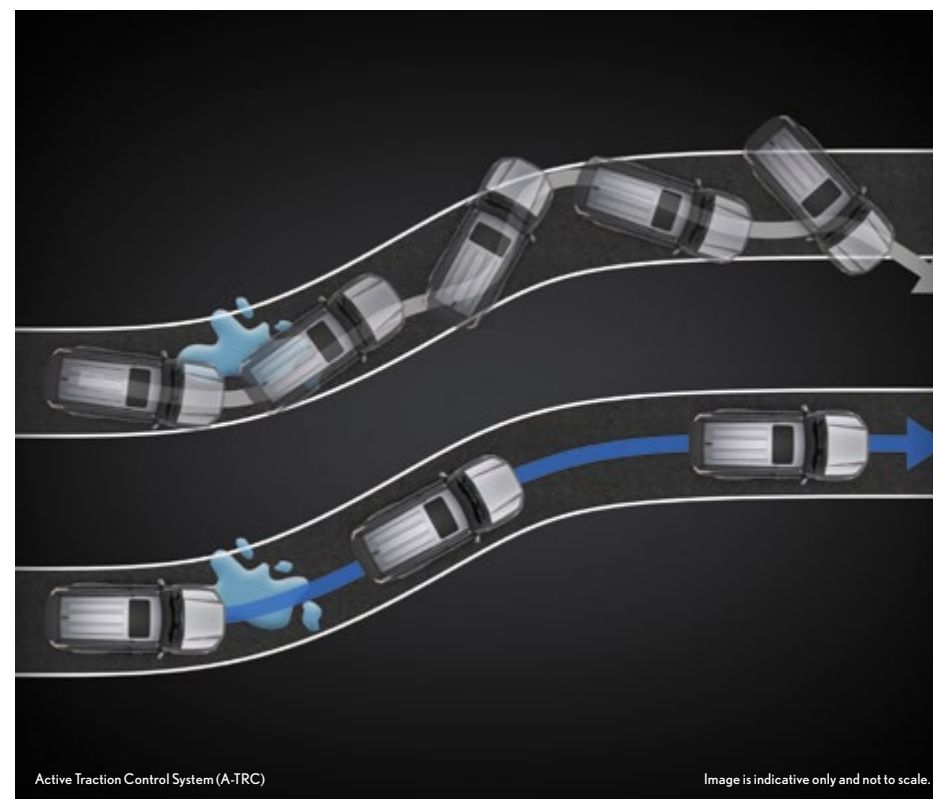
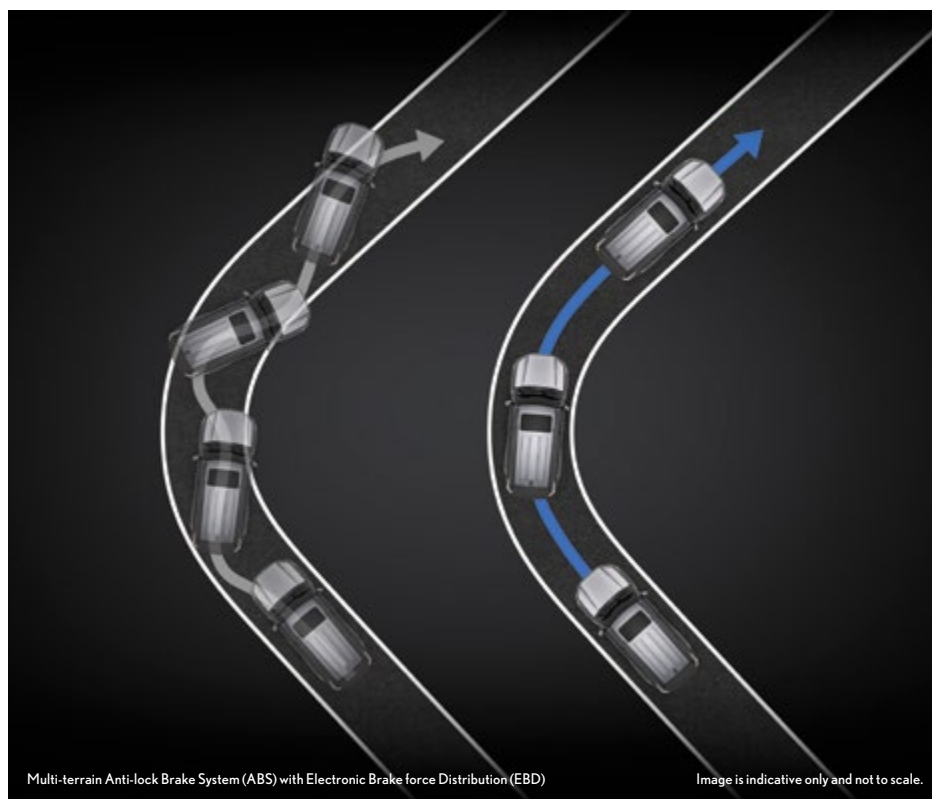
Ride Comfort¹

Delicate acceleration/deceleration control is required for off-road driving. The GX exhibits excellent pedal control on rough roads, allowing the driver to precisely control both the gas and brake pedals even at low speeds. Adaptive-Variable Suspension (AVS), available on Sports Luxury and Overtrail grades only, electronically controls the dampening force of the four shock absorbers according to driving input and road conditions. By utilising a linear solenoid type actuator that enables precise switching of dampening force, the system reduces input and enhances vehicle stability, even when encountering road surfaces with a mix of large undulations and minor irregularities. It offers excellent steering response, stability, and ride comfort. VSC helps prevent loss of control in extreme situations. In addition, information obtained from vertical G-sensor signals, steering sensor signals, speed sensor signals, etc. are used to enable optimal dampening force control.

Steering Control¹

An Electric Power Steering (EPS) system featuring a motor and reduction gearbox has been adopted. During off-road driving, the system minimises kickback caused by road surface obstacles, helping to provide a stable and confident driving experience. The system offers a responsive and easy-to-manoeuve steering feel suitable for various speeds, from low to high. Steering rigidity is enhanced by the use of a large diameter shaft and tube, and the circular structure connecting the instrument panel reinforcement to the cowl frame effectively transfers inputs from the steering wheel. This provides exceptional lateral steering rigidity, contributing to the excellent responsiveness and vibration suppression.

Proportions rooted in off-road functionality and an interior providing exceptional comfort even in the harshest environments.



Design Overview (Exterior)

The design concept of the GX is "HIGH END × PROFESSIONAL." As a genuine Lexus off-roader, it embodies a refined outdoor lifestyle by combining functional essence and dynamic performance in its proportions and distinctive design. The exterior showcases rugged yet modern proportions, with a front spindle expression that reflects its off-road capabilities. The front pillars of the vehicle are pulled back and raised, creating the square silhouette of a genuine off-roader. The high hood silhouette further enhances this look. Additionally, the vehicle's horizontal body axis and prominent wheel flares contribute to its solid and commanding stance.

Front and Side Design

The design blends the iconic “spindle body,” the distinctive spindle grille of Lexus now represented as a mass, with a rugged and functional protective shape. The centre section is equipped with a protective covering to safeguard the vehicle’s components from obstacles encountered during off-road excursions, such as rocks, grass, and trees. The sides feature a grille opening that extends downward to accommodate the sub-radiator, providing both cooling functionality and a unique visual identity befitting of a true off-roader. The low hood centre enhances forward visibility, while the high and angular corners of the hood instill a sense of confidence and security when navigating challenging terrain.

Headlamps

The headlamps integrate a slim 3-projector Bi-LED unit and BladeScan Adaptive High-beam System¹ (AHS) to provide excellent light distribution and effective visibility at night. The high position of the headlamps and the 3-dimensional L-shape signature Daytime Running Light (DRL) exude a strong, resolute expression.



Front Face

The contrast created by the body-coloured front upper bumper and the black of the lower bumper, radiator grille, headlamp bezels and cornering lamp bezel, exudes a sense of luxury.

Rear Design

The GX boasts a solid stance, thanks to the extended front and rear fenders, while the sculpted and rugged body design evokes a sense of toughness and modernity. The rear is adorned with a single horizontal combination lamp and the iconic Lexus logotype, serving as a symbol of the brand. Positioned at a higher level, the rear combination lamps provide enhanced visibility in wooded areas or low-visibility conditions, alerting others to the presence of the vehicle when driving in formation.

Interior Design Concept

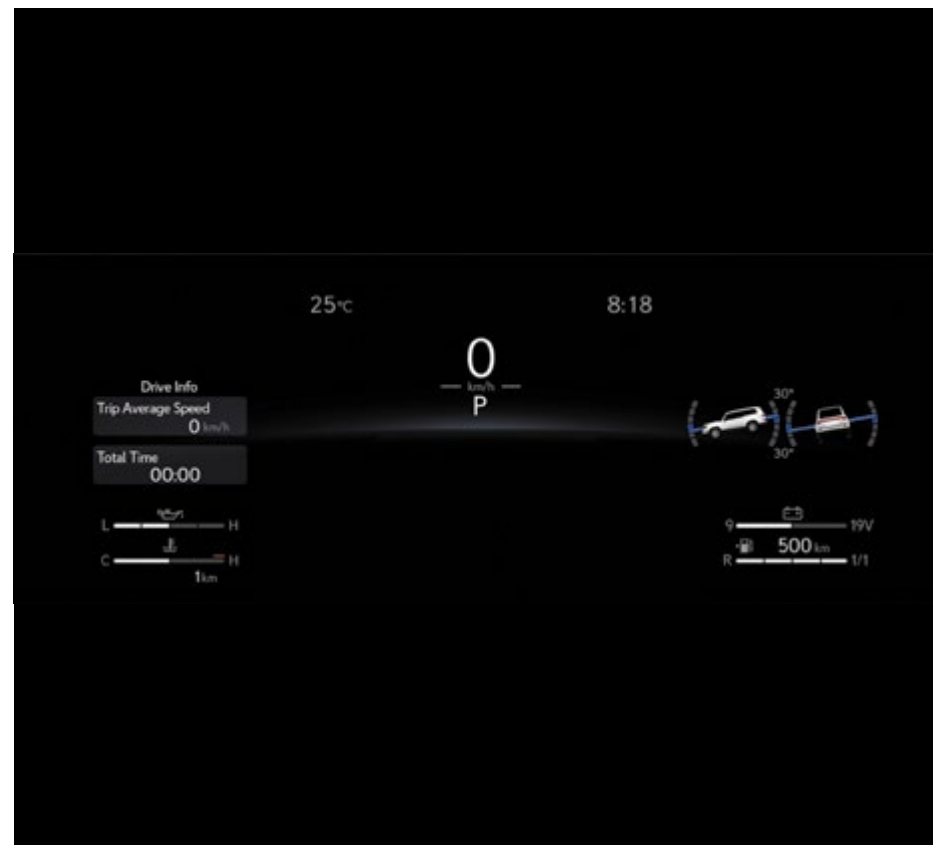
The interior was designed to emulate the ambiance of a modern and comfortable forest cabin, complete with a digital environment to create a truly tranquil space. To enhance the driver's perception of vehicle posture during off-roading, a clean horizontal/vertical layout is employed, centred around the top of the instrument panel. The centre display is positioned low to maximise forward visibility, contributing to a sense of security for the driver. Furthermore, a metallic accent traverses the centre of the instrument panel, creating an open and spacious ambiance. The cockpit features a centre display with strategically placed kneepads, combining sleek design with meticulous craftsmanship, resulting in a modern and comfortable environment. The large 14-inch touch display at the centre, provides easy access to various functions. While it incorporates soft switches for streamlined integration, essential controls such as the heater and audio utilise physical switches for quick and convenient operation. Attention to detail was given to the size, shape, layout, and display information of the switches, for an intuitive user experience.

TAZUNA Concept

The functional cockpit design is rooted in the innovative "Tazuna Concept," which represents the next stage in Lexus' "human-centred" philosophy. Taking inspiration from the connection between the reins and a rider's control over a horse, the steering wheel switches are seamlessly integrated with the Head-up Display, enabling the driver to effortlessly operate essential functions like navigation and audio, thereby promoting a seamless driving experience and minimising the need for extensive eye movements.



Meter

The large 12.3-inch graphic metre integrates three customisable, multi-information displays that allow simultaneous display of different information. The contents in the multi-information display can be changed using switches in the steering wheel.

Front Seats

The front seats were designed to provide a comfortable driving posture with minimum fatigue even when driving for long periods of time. Optimising stiffness of the lower seatback spring, seat cushion and seatback lateral holding performance enhances both support and posture control, and provides a feeling of unity with the vehicle. Front seat massagers (available on Sports Luxury models only) apply pressure to the body from the thighs to the shoulders, to provide physical and emotional refreshment. The power 10-way driver (available on Sports Luxury models only) and 8-way front passenger seats enable occupants to quickly tailor their preferred position for comfort and support, and for drivers only, saves 3 seat positions in memory. A power easy access system provides slide away and return functionality, enhancing easy ingress and egress.

7-seater Model (Available on Luxury and Sports Luxury models only)

The second-row features a 60:40 split folding bench seat with a convenient one-touch tumble function that folds the seat out of the way to allow smooth ingress and egress to the third-row seats from either side of the vehicle. Integrated second-row seat heaters provide 3-levels of heat to effectively warm the shoulders and lumbar region. The third-row seat is a 50:50 split double flat seat, that folds the headrest down and away before folding the seat flat, enhancing usable luggage space. The couple distance between the second-row and third-row seats contributes to ample legroom in the third-row seats, which together with the excellent heel space provided by the seat frame design, enhances passenger comfort.

Multi-Colour Illumination

The multi-colour illumination, available on Sports Luxury models only, around the instrument panel creates a spacious, immersive atmosphere especially at night. 14 colours were carefully selected to express the changing emotions and feelings of witnessing beautiful natural phenomena. In addition to the theme colours, you can select from 50 additional colours from a colour palette that can be displayed in the centre display.

Luggage Space

The ample luggage space accommodates the gear you need for an extended adventure in the outdoors, together with convenient underdeck storage for tools and small items. The lift-up type glass hatch is opened using a switch integrated next to the hatch, enabling easy loading/unloading of luggage in a narrow parking lot, when using the towing hitch, and without getting wet on a rainy day. The power back door operation is quick and quiet.

Lexus is continuously developing safety technologies with one goal: Zero fatalities and injuries from traffic accidents. To get closer to realising this objective, the GX incorporates Lexus Safety System+¹. By expanding and evolving each function and adding new systems, we aim to help prevent traffic accidents, further reduce traffic fatalities and reduce the burden on the driver.

If the system judges the driver's state is inappropriate (distracted, poor posture, etc.), alerts and notifications are issued. In addition to detecting the face direction and eyes open/closed state, the driver's sight line is also detected, allowing detection of distracted driving states which cannot be judged solely from the face direction (facing forwards with sight line lowered looking at cell phone, etc.).

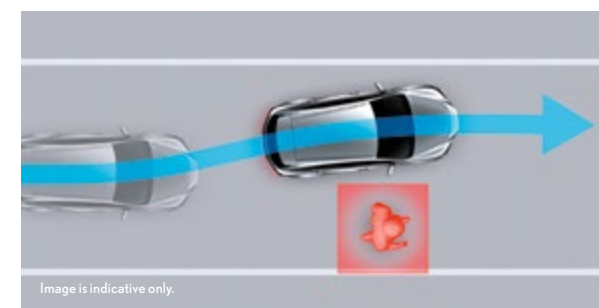
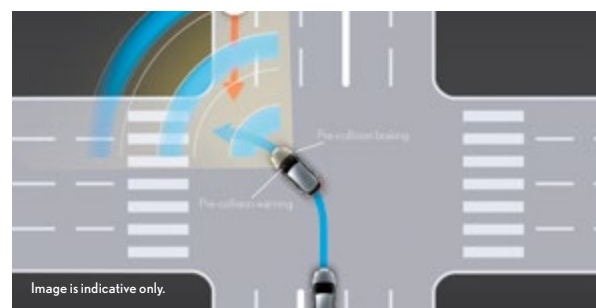
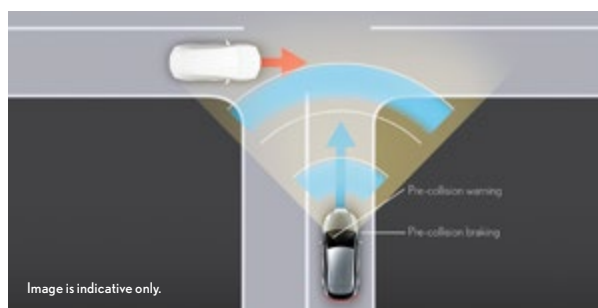

Pre-Collision System¹

When the millimetre-wave radar and monocular camera sensors detect a vehicle, pedestrian, bicyclist or motorcycle (daylight only) ahead and determine that a collision is likely, it is designed to alert the driver with a buzzer and on the display. If the driver activates the brakes, then pre-collision brake assist supplements the force being applied to the pedal. If the driver cannot depress the brake pedal, the system is designed to automatically activate pre-collision braking to help avoid a collision or mitigate the impact force. If the system determines there is a high possibility of a frontal collision with an oncoming vehicle, it is designed to alert the driver and activates the brakes to help mitigate injury to people and damage to the vehicle.



Intersection Assistance (Crossing Vehicle)^{1,2}

In addition to the normal Pre-Collision System operating range, the system also supports collision avoidance with vehicles and motorcycles crossing at intersections. If the system determines that a collision is likely, it is designed to alert the driver and activates the brakes to help mitigate damage.¹

Intersection Assistance (Right/Left Turn)^{1,2}

When turning right or left at an intersection, if the millimetre-wave radar and monocular camera sensors detect an oncoming vehicle (in up to 2 adjacent lanes) going straight when turning right or left, or pedestrians and cyclists crossing from the opposite direction, it is designed to alert the driver and activates the brakes to help avoid a collision and mitigate damage.¹

Emergency Steering Assist^{1,2}

If the Emergency Steering Assist system detects a collision with a vehicle, motorcycle, pedestrian or cyclist ahead is likely and there is sufficient space for the vehicle to be steered within its lane and the driver has begun an evasive steering manoeuvre, it is designed to assist steering to help enhance vehicle stability and prevent lane departure. In addition, even if the driver doesn't move the steering wheel, an optional active steering function supports collision avoidance by moving the vehicle within its lane while gently braking.¹

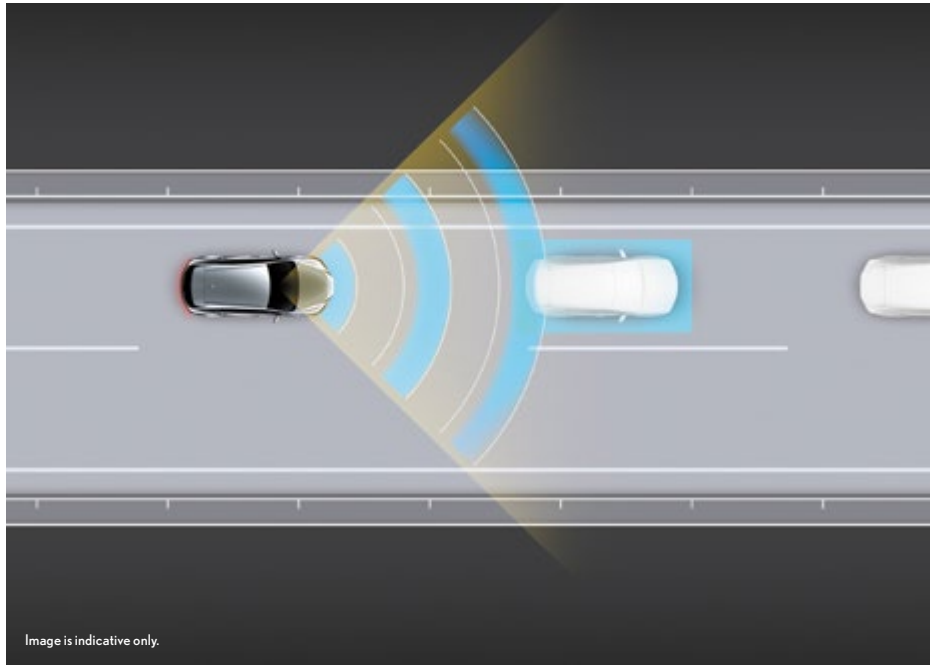

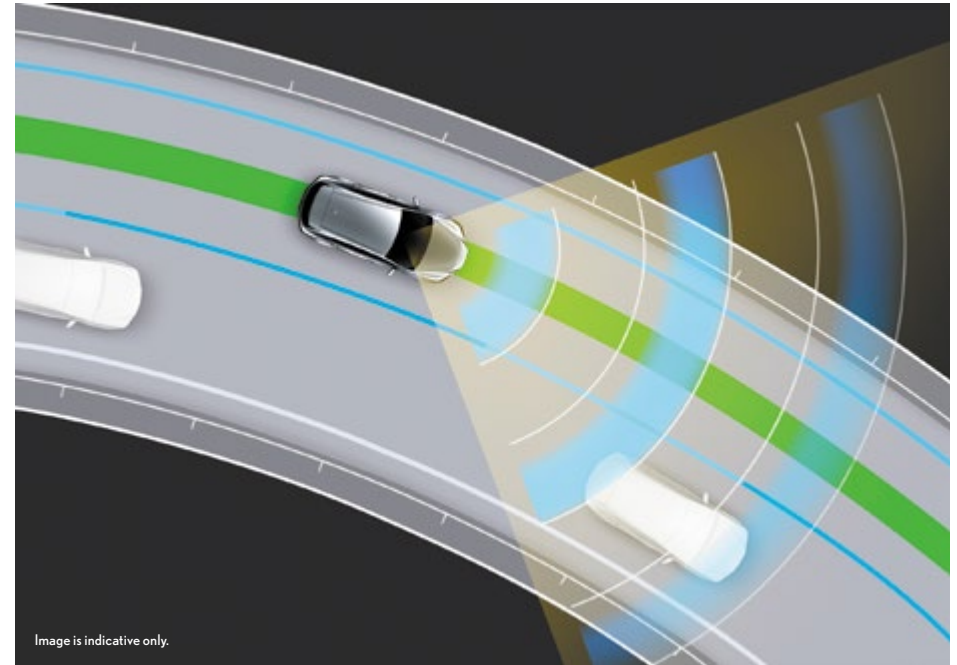

Dynamic Radar Cruise Control (With full speed range)¹

In addition to maintaining a constant speed, Dynamic Radar Cruise Control uses the millimetre-wave radar and monocular camera sensors to detect a vehicle driving in front and is designed to maintain an appropriate distance between the vehicles. When the driver operates the turn signal lamp at approximately 80km/h or over, preliminary acceleration is applied when following a preceding vehicle that is travelling slower than the preset vehicle speed. Alternatively, preliminary deceleration is applied when changing lanes into a lane where there is a preceding vehicle that is travelling slower than the preset vehicle speed, helping smooth overtaking and lane change. Furthermore, when approaching and driving through a curve, the Curve Speed Reduction Function is designed to decelerate the vehicle, reducing the need to cancel Dynamic Radar Cruise Control operation, enhancing driver convenience.



Lane Tracing Assist (LTA)¹

When driving on freeways and highways or automobile-only roads with lane lines using Dynamic Radar Cruise Control, the system helps assist the steering operation required to keep the vehicle in its lane. Enhanced recognition and control performance enable assistance on gentle curves, smoothly keeping the vehicle in the centre of its lane with minimal swaying.

Acceleration Suppression at Low Speed^{1,2}

The millimetre-wave radar and monocular camera sensors detect pedestrians, cyclists, and vehicles in front of the vehicle. If the accelerator is depressed hard while the vehicle is stopped or travelling slowly with an object in front, the system is designed to limit acceleration by low G braking to help avoid a collision or mitigate damage. In addition, when a collision is avoided and the vehicle stops, braking force is maintained until the driver operates the accelerator or brake.

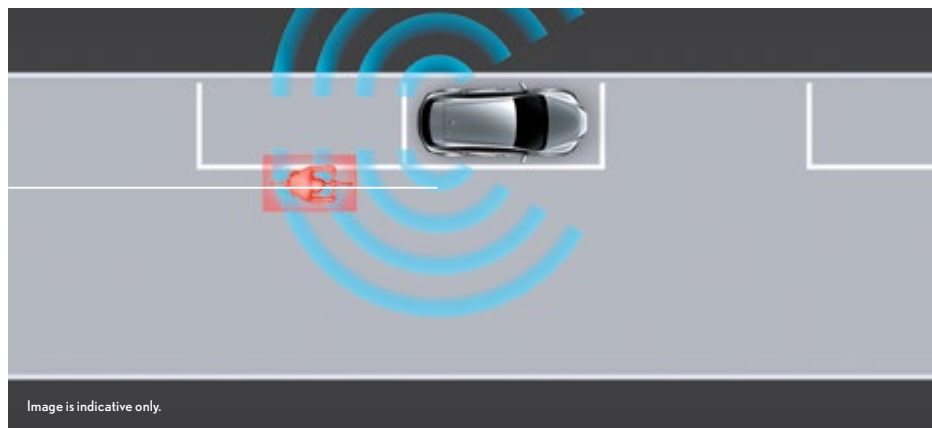

Safe Exit Assist (SEA)¹

SEA uses the Blind Spot Monitor System (BSM) to detect vehicles (including bicycles, during daylight only) approaching from the rear when exiting the vehicle. If SEA determines a collision with an opened door or exiting occupants is a possibility, an indicator in the door mirror lights up to alert occupants. If there is the possibility of a collision when the door is opened, or while the door is open, occupants are alerted by flashing indicators in the door mirror, the multi-information display, buzzer, and voice notification.

Blind Spot Monitor (BSM)¹

During lane changes, the BSM uses rear lateral side millimetre-wave radar to detect vehicles present in the blind spots (areas in adjacent lanes that cannot be seen using the outer mirrors), and is designed to alert the driver using an indicator in the outer mirror and a buzzer.

Road Sign Assist (RSA)¹ (Speed Signs Only)

To help support safe driving, RSA uses the monocular camera to is designed to detect speed limit signs, and displays them on the multi-information display and Head-up Display. While a speed limit sign is displayed, RSA notifies the driver if the vehicle speed exceeds the displayed speed limit + the specified threshold value.

Adaptive High Beam System (AHS)¹ (Available on Sports Luxury models only)

The system detects the headlamps and tail lamps of other vehicles on the road, and the ambient brightness of the road along with the surrounding areas. When it detects a vehicle within the area illuminated by high beams, it is designed to individually dim/brighten 12 LEDs in each headlamp to precisely control the lit and unlit areas, optimising light distribution for both the driver and other road users. By partially dimming light from the high beam headlamps so that they don't directly shine towards another vehicle on the road, the system helps enhance visibility at night.

Automatic High Beam (AHB)¹

Automatic High Beam, which automatically turns the high beam lamps off if another vehicle is detected and automatically turns the high beam lamps on once the vehicle is gone, has been adopted.

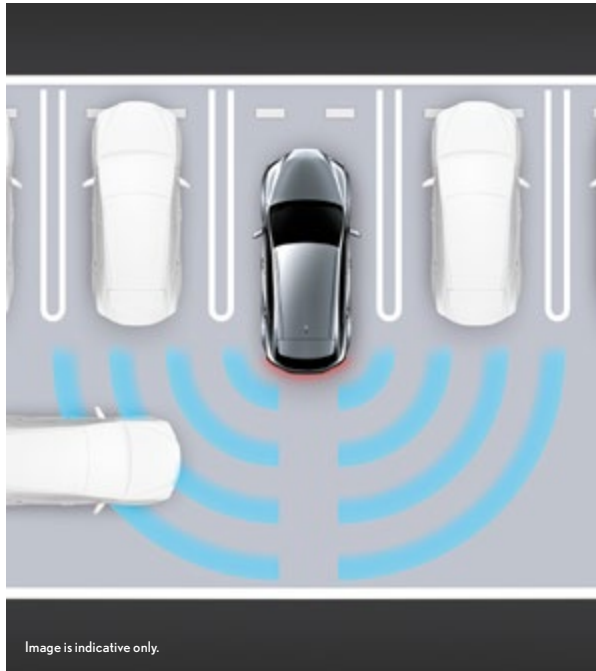
